## “The Southern Stampede Piston Cup”

The top six fastest Cats/Tunnels and Mono's will go head to head - winner takes all.

## “Night Race Concourse”

Novelty prize awarded to the *best pimped out/blinged up* FE Mono. Boats do not have to be entered into the class racing but must comply with AMPBA rules for electric classes.

## Entry Fees

Registration fee (includes first boat)	\$ 30.00
Each additional boat	\$ 10.00
Junior Entries (all boats, No reg fee )	\$5.00

## Rules:

- All competitors must be financial members of the AMPBA.
- AMPBA rules and code of conduct will apply.
- All entries must have alternate frequency. (2.4Ghz EXEMPT)
- Minimum of five (5) boats to form a class. (4) Boat classes will have 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place trophies only
- Scoring will be to AMPBA system A. (Accumulated points for place)
- Competitors, pit crew & race officials only in pit area.
- No alcohol or illicit drugs to be consumed before or during each race day.
- AMPBC expects responsible behavior and consumption of alcohol at all other times
- A contest director will oversee the event, his decision is final.
- Objections as per AMPBA rules. \$100 objection fee.
- Petrol class competitors to supply their own fuel to AMPBA rules.
- Rescue boats only to be operated by those who are licensed to do so.

*By completing the entry form all competitors agree to abide by these rules.*

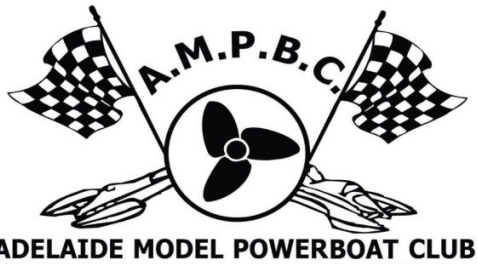
